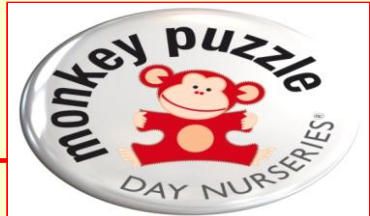
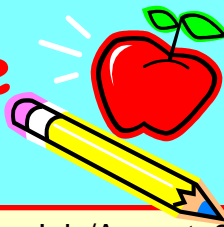

## Our First Sports Day

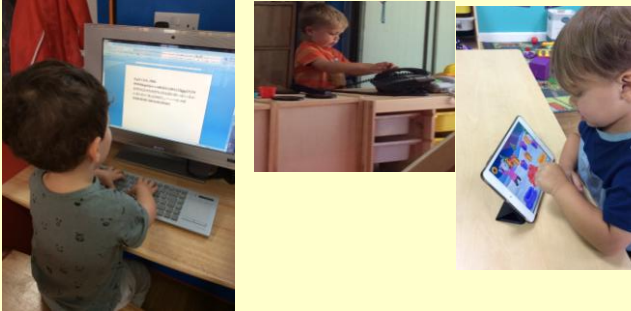
In July we celebrated our first ever sports day at Monkey Puzzle with all of the children taking part and their parents cheering them on from the side line.

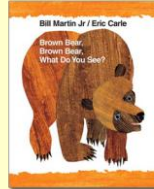


## Reminder to Parents
